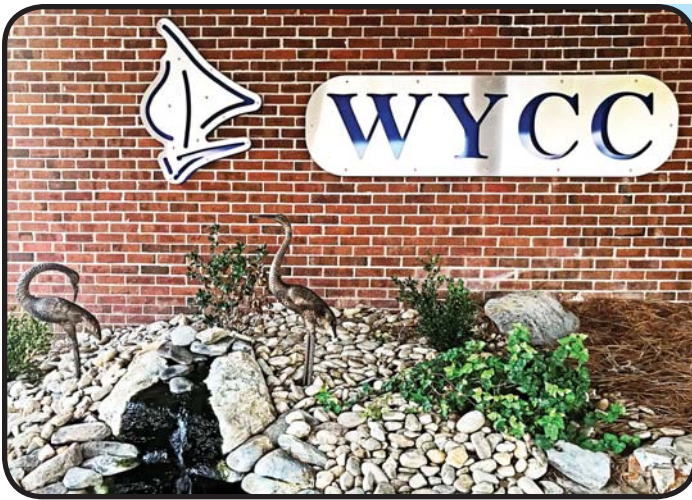


WELCOME TO OUR CLUB!

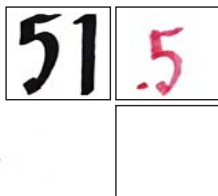

Now we want to insure that all of you are prepared in the event we get a hurricane visit. Please have your hurricane plans ready to be put into effect just in case. If you are moving your boat, have the proper anchors ready and review anchoring procedures to avoid slippage. We will notify you if your boat needs to be moved prior to a storm. Also, should you be leaving your boat at the dock, please have the proper sized dock lines and double or triple up. Make sure to leave room for the rise in the tide. If you have a trailer, it would be wise to take your boat out of the water and park in a safe spot. In any case review the WYCC rules for hurricanes.

We still have Fuel! Members receive a \$.30 discount per gallon, but you do not have to be a member in order to fuel from the WYCC docks.

Warm weather will continue to be with us for a while so enjoy the remaining excellent boating weather. Should you have boating needs, please let me know and thank you for supporting the WYCC!

Tennis/Pickleball Courts

What is pickleball exactly? For the uninitiated, pickleball is something of a mix between tennis, racquetball and ping pong. Players use special paddles and a wiffle ball, and games take place on tennis courts with specific pickleball lines. Nets and court sizes are smaller than their tennis counterparts, and the most common game is doubles, although singles is also an option. It has its own set of quirky rules — for instance, try to stay out of the “kitchen”— but they’re easy to learn. The game appeals for several reasons. “For one, it’s very social, “You’ll see a big mix of demographics out there. It is a mental component. “You need to out-think your opponent so there’s a lot of strategy that goes into playing. The game is also quick, making it a convenient way to get in some exercise. Games in a typical league run only 15 minutes each — you can get in as little or as much as you want. People have worn their fitness tracker when playing and after two hours, they have moved the equivalent of four miles of walking. But the nice thing is that if you’re playing doubles, you can get in a workout without killing yourself.



Pickleball is for everyone it is a great family sport. Anyone can play, from eight-year olds up to 100-year olds. It’s great for hand-eye coordination for younger kids. So try out our Courts which can be reserved anytime between 8 am to 8 pm by calling the Pro Shop at 252-946-3245.
